Subject: Upgradation of School from Secondary to Senior Secondary level with effect from academic session 93-94 (without aid) in Science and Humanities streams.

Sir,

With reference to your application on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the approval of the Director of Education, Delhi for the upgradation of the existing secondary school to senior secondary level with effect from 1993-94 session. Sr. Secondary classes will be run without aid subject to the fulfilment of the following terms and conditions-

1. That the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act and Rules 1973, as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
2. That the school shall admit the students without any discrimination of caste and creed.
3. That the school will meet the additional liability of senior secondary classes by appointing more staff as per the norms of the department and subjectwise posts shall be appointed and Govt. nominee shall also be invited at the time of the selection of the Teachers.
4. That the proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per student and more approved standard books for senior classes and reference books for teachers shall be added by July, 1994, and a qualified librarian be appointed.
5. That more sport material for out-door games shall be purchased and made available to the students immediately during 1994-95.
6. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of Section 10(1) of the Delhi School Education Act 1973, and payment shall be made through crossed cheques. Bonus, LTC, medical allowance, gratuity and pension as applicable to Govt. Employees of Delhi Administration shall be paid to the employees of the school.
7. That the enrolment of each section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12 sq. ft. per student for the available floor area of the class room and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Directorate of Education. Number of sections should not exceed the number of existing class rooms of proper size in the school and each class room, science labs, and library rooms may be fitted with proper electrical appliances.

8. That the school shall not run unrecognised classes or any other activities within the school premises and all the recognised classes shall be run at one place at the above address only. Nursery classes if any, be removed from the premises of the school immediately.
9. That the school shall recruit the Teachers and other employees as per recruitment rules framed under DSER 1973. Services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, shall be dispensed with immediate effect.
10. That all the facilities prescribed under Rule 50 and 51 of the Delhi School Education Rules, 1973 shall be made available to the students.
11. That the arrangement for good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as to the teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health Certificate may be obtained from the Local Body within a month.
12. That the violation of any instructions/orders/conditions/rules and regulations of the Department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school.
13. That the school building shall be constructed within a period of two years.
